ICE STORM DEBRIS

Of course, this is the most challenging event we've faced in a long time. Residents have put a lot of effort into cleaning up their property and moving debris to the roadsides. For over a month board members pursued options for picking up the wood piles and were very grateful to learn that, since our roads are state maintained (yea!), VDOT will provide roadside clean-up! Especially grateful because other contractors who reviewed the community would not take on this large a job - the only estimate received was \$30,000, which would have involved a special assessment to the residents. But we are told that VDOT will provide the service for no extra charge. Unfortunately, due to the extent of the damage in the region, it may be four weeks before VDOT is able to come to WGMV. After VDOT's efforts the board will determine if more clean-up is needed. We'll keep you up to date.

UPDATE TO COMMUNITY FACEBOOK GROUP

The WG/BW FB group can be a real asset to residents - reporting traffic issues, lost/found pets, interesting activities, etc. But occasionally it has been a forum for unpleasant exchanges.
